Class 2	Heaviest apples.	5 of any culinary variety to be displayed on a plate, which will be provided by the Show.

* Please note that the count number relates to the number of cavities in the tray liner. You will need a corresponding number of fruit to fill the liner in each Class, plus 3 loose apples for inspection of internal condition.

Rules & Regulations

1. All classes open to individuals, partnerships and co-operatives, in whose name an exhibit has been entered, and must have grown the same.
2. No prize will be awarded to an exhibit, which does not, in the opinion of the judge, possess sufficient merit.
3. The Secretary and appointed Stewards to accept apples, dessert or culinary as described and catalogued by the UK National Fruit Collections, Brogdale.
4. Judging to commence at 5pm on Thursday 23 September 2021.
5. Exhibitors may deliver their entries from noon on Thursday 23 September until 4.45pm. All exhibitors must leave the display area by 4.45pm ready for judging at 5pm.
6. The decision of the judge is final.
7. Class 1 Double layer tray to be provided by and delivered by Produce Packaging, Ledbury (for details see schedule). Apples to be packed with eye facing upwards.

Class 2 (variety to be named) Plate will be provided at the Showground.

Classes 3-10 (varieties to be named and size range indicated in all classes). Single layer tray provided by and delivered by Produce Packaging, Ledbury (for details see schedule). Use 39 count tray for smaller size range and 35 count tray for higher size range

For classes 3-8, all apples facing same way in tray with eye of apple facing the end of box.

No identification as to the competitor should be shown on the exhibit except for the exhibit number, which will be allocated when the exhibit arrives.

8. Exhibits are not to be removed until 3.15pm on Sunday 26 September. If exhibitors are willing to donate them please indicate on the entry form, and an auction of fruit will take place with the funds going towards the Society's educational support.
